



Skin Care Treatment In Savannah, GA

Botox

Botox is the only FDA-approved skin care treatment to temporarily improve the appearance of both moderate to severe frown lines between the brows and crow's feet lines in adults. It is one of the most extensively studied medical aesthetic treatments. The safety and efficacy of Botox have been evaluated in both clinical trials, as well as in more than 400 peer-reviewed articles in scientific and medical journals.

Botox targets one of the underlying causes of frown lines and crow's feet – the repeated muscle contractions from frowning and squinting over the years. When injected with Botox, muscle activity is temporarily reduced, and you will begin to notice a visible smoothing of your crow's feet lines and frown lines between your brows.

For the crow's feet area, we inject three areas of the orbicularis oculi, which is the muscle that frames the side of the eye. This will be then repeated on the orbicularis oculi muscle on the other eye. Injecting Botox into the muscles that cause crow's feet lines temporarily reduces the activity of those muscles. The result is a reduction in the appearance of those lines.

For the frown lines area, we administer five injections into muscles in your forehead – one in the procerus muscle and four in the corrugator muscles. Injecting Botox into the muscles that cause frown lines temporarily reduces the activity of those muscles. The result is a reduction in the appearance of those lines.

The actual injection process takes about 10 minutes, but we will discuss your treatment goals and perform a facial analysis to determine the appropriate treatment areas for you. Once your initial treatment is complete, you may begin to notice results within 24 to 48 hours for moderate to severe frown lines, with results lasting up to four months.

We may use ice to numb the treatment area. If you are concerned about discomfort, we may apply a topical numbing cream before administering your treatment. Treatment requires minimal downtime or recovery; it's often called a lunchtime procedure. You'll be able to go about your normal routine immediately after leaving our Savannah, GA, office.

Juvéderm

Juvéderm is a skin care procedure that offers instant, natural-looking results for up to one year with optimal treatment. It is the first and only non-surgical hyaluronic acid (HA) filler FDA-approved to instantly smooth moderate to severe wrinkles around your nose and mouth.

Skin care treatment areas include:

- Parentheses (Smile) Lines
- Corner Lines
- Marionette Lines
- Vertical Lip Lines

The injection process can be performed during a brief visit to our Savannah, GA, office. You'll also need to allow time for a skin care consultation prior to treatment. Touch-up injections – as well as repeat injections – are usually needed to maintain optimal skin care results. Less gel (about half the amount) is usually needed for repeat injections.

Injections may cause some discomfort during and after the injection. However, Juvéderm is formulated with lidocaine for a more comfortable treatment experience. We may use ice to numb the treatment area. If you are concerned about discomfort, we may apply a topical numbing cream before administering your treatment. Treatment requires minimal downtime or recovery.

Radiesse

Radiesse is a skin care dermal filler that is indicated for hand augmentation to correct volume loss in the back of the hands, and for smoothing moderate to severe facial wrinkles and folds, such as nasolabial folds (the creases that extend from the corner of your nose to the corner of your mouth).

Skin care treatment areas include:

- Smile Lines
- Marionette Lines
- Corners of the Mouth
- Pre-Jowl
- Chin Wrinkles

Radiesse is injected through a small needle and placed under the skin. Immediately, this skin care filler works to add volume under the skin and, over time, the benefits of Radiesse continue by naturally stimulating your body's own natural collagen. The natural results have been shown to last a year or more in many patients, making the treatment results both immediate and long lasting.

Benefits of Radiesse include:

- Radiesse immediately replenishes lost volume and stimulates the production of your own natural collagen with results that can last a year or more in many patients.
- Over time, the gel is absorbed and the body metabolizes the CaHA microspheres leaving behind only your own natural collagen.

- Radiesse is FDA approved to mix with lidocaine, an anesthetic, to significantly reduce injection-related pain

Latisse

Latisse is a prescription treatment for hypotrichosis (inadequate or not enough lashes) to grow eyelashes longer, fuller, and darker. Full results take as long as 16 weeks, which is why it is important that, once you begin using Latisse, you must continue applying the topical solution each night and follow the directions for best results. If you stop using Latisse at any time, your eyelashes will return to their previous appearance over several weeks to months.

As the treatment progresses, you'll first begin to see changes in length. Then, gradually, you'll notice more thickness and darkness in your lashes. Clinical trial results showed lashes were:

- 25% longer
- 106% fuller
- 18% darker
